



## Buckinghamshire Hockey Association Code of Conduct—Players

### Expected Minimum Standards of Behaviour

#### Individuals will, at all times respect

- the rules and regulations of hockey.
- the rules and regulations of any venue which they are attending.
- and encourage the spirit of fair play.
- the dignity and worth of others.
- umpires, officials, coaches, players of all teams and other spectators.
- understand, and appreciate that the purpose of the activities is primarily development and enjoyment, not just competing to win.

#### Players will

- be punctual to meeting times, training and for matches
- be dressed appropriately for their activity, wearing the correct Bucks HA clothing where required.
- conduct themselves in a manner which protects their own safety and the safety of others.
- be familiar with and abide by England Hockey's anti-doping and equality policies.
- be aware when participating in matches that you are representing Buckingham Hockey Association and behave in a manner which preserves its reputation.

#### Players will never

- smoke at any activity or meeting.
- participate whilst under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- use inappropriate or abusive language, bullying or threatening behaviour
- act in any way which brings the sport or Buckinghamshire Hockey Association into disrepute.
